

NHSC STUDENTS TO SERVICE (S2S) LOAN REPAYMENT PROGRAM AWARDEE RESPONSIBILITIES

National Health Service Corps (NHSC) Students to Service (S2S) Awardees are required to:

- 1** **Notify** the NHSC through the [online Customer Service Portal](#) immediately if any of the **following events** are anticipated or have occurred:
 - A change of name, mailing address, telephone number, email or financial information.
 - A change in enrollment status that would affect your graduation date.
 - A leave of absence or dismissal from school or your residency training program.
 - A change in your residency training. *[Participants who, at any time, pursue training that is not approved under the NHSC S2S Program (e.g., non-primary health care programs or unaccredited residency training) will be subject to damages.]*
- 2** **Maintain full-time enrollment** and **good academic standing** in medical school through graduation and graduate from medical school before July 1, 2012. Failure to notify the NHSC of a change in your enrollment status will adversely impact your award and possibly lead to recommendation for default.
- 3** **Match** to and successfully **complete** an **accredited primary care residency** program in an NHSC-approved specialty.
- 4** **Fulfill your service commitment upon completion of your post-graduate training.** You will be invited to a Placement Conference at the beginning of your last year of residency to aid in your transition to service. During this conference, you will receive information on fulfilling your service commitment and will be able to meet representatives of sites that are eligible for placement of NHSC S2S LRP participants.
