

Script for radio Public Service Announcements (PSA) – This document will be used by radio stations who want to provide information about Corps Community Day, the National Health Service Corps, Health Professional Shortage Areas, and primary care careers. The script is for PSAs intended to be read on-air by the radio announcer. PSAs should be created for a specific time :15, :30 and/or :60 seconds. (An extra step would be to record the radio spots here at HRSA and then have the audio files available for download.)
