MD/DO Job Description

The MD/DO is expected to assess plans and provide patient care, provide exams, perform comprehensive physical examinations, make appropriate diagnosis, prescribe treatment and medications, compile patient medical data, which will include but not be limited to health history and results of physical examinations, request necessary tests and follow-up visits and refer patients to specialists, as necessary. The clinician may be required to work independently when needed, perform supervision on midlevel practitioners and other medical staff, but work closely with the healthcare team of the CMC and reports directly to the facility's Medical Director.

Nurse Practitioner/Physician Assistant Job Description

The provider is required to work in a family practice rural health clinic under the supervision of a physician. It is expected that the provider can work independently but also work closely with medical doctors and other members of the health care team of the CMC. Primarily, responsibilities would include provision of general and preventative care, conduct check-ups, treat illnesses, order lab tests and prescribe medication for children and adults. It is also expected that they educate patients about preventative care and discuss with them the prescribed treatments and plan of care. They may also conduct physicals, and order the necessary tests and screenings.
