The Tennessee Department of Health is actively recruiting for Primary Care Physicians and Advanced Nurse Practitioners to provide healthcare in County Health Departments located in Stewart, Bedford, Roane and Putnam counties. The Health Department Clinics play a critical role in ensuring that all Tennesseans have access to healthcare despite economic and geographic barriers.

The Department of Health, local health department clinics provide the following services: immunizations; communicable and environmental disease control; general environmental health; women, infants, and children (WIC); family planning; maternal and child health; dental services, and primary care for all age groups across the East, Middle, and West Tennessee region.

Clinic hours are 8:00-4:30, M-F. After hours call is limited to telephone triage and is rotated among APNs with Physician back-up. Patient's charges are based on income. The Tennessee Department of Health offers a competitive salary and great benefits including paid holidays, 401-K, state pension plan, health and dental insurance, life insurance, paid sick and annual leave and CME opportunities.
