

- An Opportunity to Serve.** As a Corps member, you are part of a community of providers and sites that are committed to making a difference in the lives of those living in communities with limited access to care. As one person you can do a lot, but as a member of the Corps, you are a part of something bigger—together we are making access to high-quality health care a reality for millions of people across the Nation.
- A Sense of Community.** The NHSC offers a variety of opportunities to connect with other Corps members and share your experiences.
