



National Health Service Corps Scholarship Program

The NHSC is a network of more than 8,000 primary health care professionals providing culturally competent primary care at more than 10,000 health care sites in urban, rural, and frontier areas. To support their service, the NHSC provides students and primary care providers with financial support in the form of scholarships and loan repayment.

What is the NHSC Scholarship Program?

The NHSC awards scholarships each year to students pursuing careers in primary care. The scholarship includes:

- Payment for tuition, required fees, and other reasonable educational costs
- Monthly support stipend
- Assistance in finding a practice site

In return, students commit to serve in the Corps for two to four years in an underserved community upon graduation and licensure.

 - Medicine (MD or DO)
 - Dentistry (DDS or DMD)
 - Nurse practitioner
 - Certified nurse-midwife
 - Physician assistant (in primary care)
