

FREE TRAINING TO PROVIDE MEDICATIONS for OPIOID USE DISORDER (MOUD) TREATMENT

Do you want to help patients with opioid use disorder? Eligible health care providers have access to free training to obtain a DATA 2000 Waiver, which allows them to deliver medications for opioid use disorder (MOUD) treatment.

HRSA's National Health Service Corps (NHSC) is connecting you to this opportunity via SAMHSA's Providers Clinical Support System (PCSS).

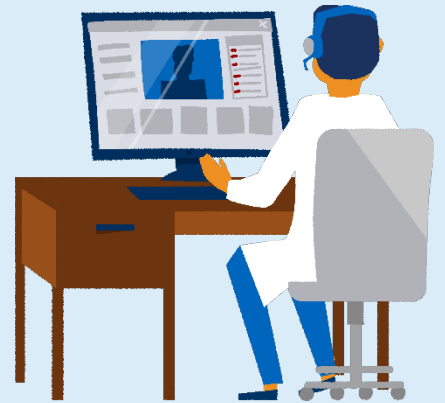
ELIGIBLE DISCIPLINES

- Physicians (MD or DO)
- Nurse Practitioners (NP)
- Physician Assistants (PA)
- Certified Nurse-Midwives (CNM)
- Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetists
- Medical Students

The Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) issues DATA 2000 Waivers to qualified health care providers, allowing them to dispense the controlled substances used in MOUD.

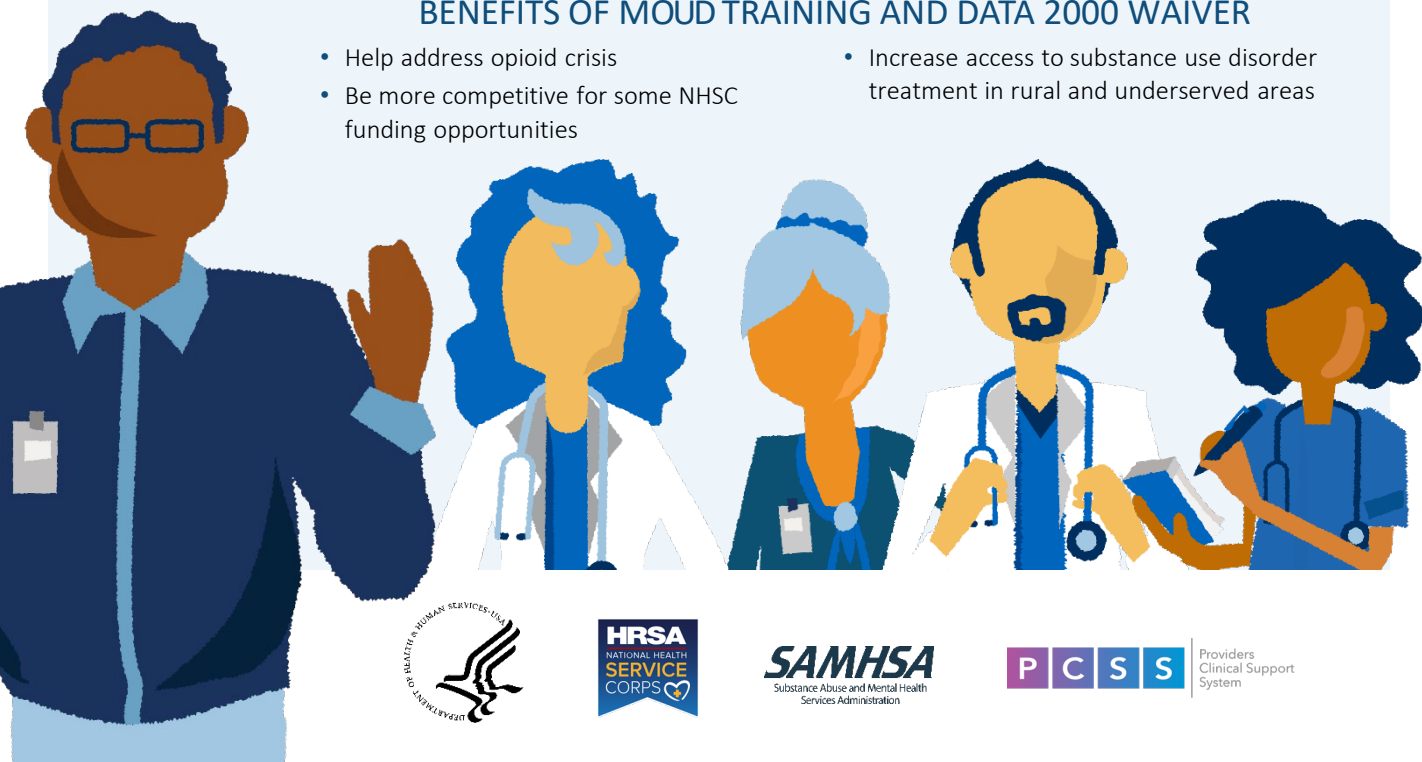


ABOUT THE TRAINING
